

## **The Results of TSCI Council plenary meeting**

The plenary meeting of Non-for-Profit Organization “International Association of Technical Survey and Classification Institutions” (TSCI) was held 23 – 25 May 2017 in Nizhny Novgorod (Russia).

During the meeting the following issues were discussed: obtaining of IMO consultative status by TSCI, execution of R&D works, as well as adoption of regulatory documents developed by Vietnam Register — “Added resistance in wave in estimate necessary time to return to port in rough sea of coastal ship” and “Calculation of roll dynamic of ship in domestic wave spectrum”.

A new Chairman of TSCI Council for the period from 26.05.2017 to May 2019 was elected — Mr. Miguel Pineda Lopez, General Director of Cuban Register of Shipping.
